BREAKING NEWS -- SWAMPS HAVE BEEN STOPPED

Lisa A. Sobecki News

State Rep. Lisa Sobecki (D-Toledo) issued a statement in response to H2Ohio's decision to pull the Cullen Park and Grassy Islands projects:

"I am pleased with H2Ohio's decision to pull the current project for Cullen Park and Grassy Island. They listened to the public's feedback, and they rightly concluded that the plan was not properly designed to address the serious environmental issues," said Rep. Sobecki. "I look forward to future conservation projects that are better designed to address the problem."

Here is copy of the City of Toledo's position regarding the Cullen Park and Grassy Island projects being pulled from the H2Ohio program:

Good afternoon,

I wanted to update you all on some information that is being released later today. The City of Toledo, Toledo Port Authority, Metroparks Toledo, and Ohio Department of Natural Resources (ODNR) will not move forward with two wetland projects in the Toledo area. The Cullen Park Wetland Restoration and the Grassy Island Restoration projects will not move forward at this time due to increased construction costs and design modifications to address public input. After engaging in the engineering and design, the expected cost showed they would not economically achieve the goals of H2Ohio at this time. All designs and plans are complete and should construction costs become more viable, they could be reconsidered in the future.

Funded as part of the H2Ohio Initiative, these projects were intended to improve water quality in Lake Erie by removing nutrients before they reach the lake. The H2Ohio funds from these projects will be reallocated to other projects that provide a more cost-effective nutrient reduction return on investment. Each H2Ohio project is carefully designed to provide the best water-quality benefit for its unique location.

Joe Cappel, VP of Business Development for the Port gave the following reason for pulling the projects:

"Because of the increased costs of construction material, and labor-shortage and supply-chain challenges, the estimated cost to construct a design that actually helped improve water quality by filtering out phosphorous came in way more expensive than what was budgeted,"

Stephanie O'Grady, spokesperson for ODNR stated:

"As technology advances and costs go down, we will continue to explore opportunities to improve water in this region. In the meantime, the funds allocated for Cullen Park and Grassy Island will be used for other projects that will reduce nutrients flowing into Lake Erie."


