The Department of Veterans Affairs, Readjustment Counseling Service, RCS, the Veterans Health Administration, VHA, and the Veterans Benefits Administration, VBA, will be at the Friendship Park Community Center on November 18, 2021, from 11:30am-2:30pm.

RCS and VHA Eligibility staff will be inside the Friendship Park Community Center while VBA Team Members will be working out of a Mobile VA Unit located in the Community Center's parking lot.

RCS Staff will provide information on VA Vet Centers and help interested and eligible veterans engage in Vet Center services.

VHA Eligibility Staff will register Veterans interested in VA Medical Benefits. Veterans should bring a copy of their DD214 although registration can take place without the DD214.

VBA Public Contact team members will answer questions on disability and pension benefits. If you are interested in filing a service-connected disability claim, or are in the process, or contemplating appealing a claim decision, VBA Public Contact team members can help you.
