This is our Christmas meeting and celebration. A special Dinner is planned by Kelly's Catering.

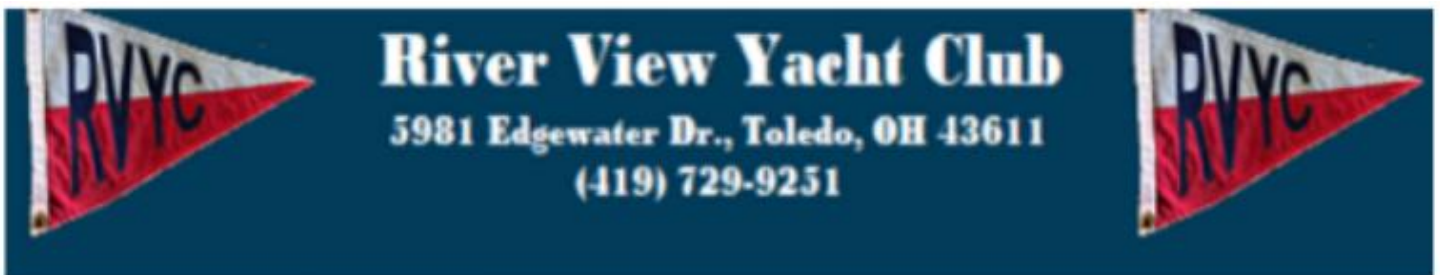

Despite the cold & rainy weather the events took place as scheduled on Sunday, December 5.

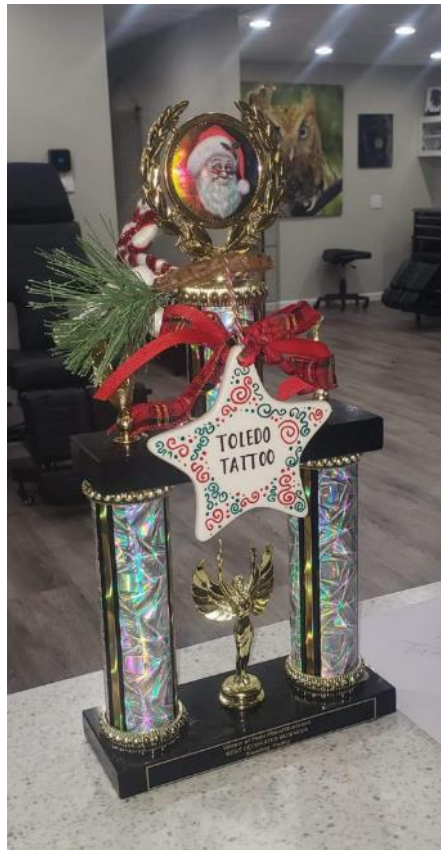
